SAAM is a project funded by the European Commission that, since its inception in 2020, has been testing an international mobility program between **Africa and Europe** in the field of vocational training.

With **36 partners from 24 countries (16 in Africa and 8 in Europe)**, SAAM has carried out more than **400 mobilities** for students and teachers from vocational training centers on both continents, providing learning and training experiences as well as internships in European companies.

How to register

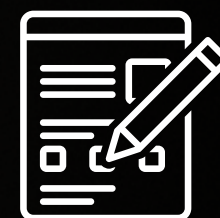
1. Go to **network.saam.global**

Basic instructions

How to join a group?

- ✓ View the groups in the homepage and click any of them to find more information.
- ✓ Find a group that you are interested in, and click on the “Join this group” button.
- ✓ And then click on the “Request Access” button.

How to accept an invitation

- ✓ Click on the notifications button in the top right corner. Then look for the latest unread notifications to find your invitation.
- ✓ Click the “Accept” button

How to add a connection and send a message

- ✓ Click on a member’s icon to see their profile and then click the “Connect” button.
- ✓ After your invitation has been accepted by the other member. A new “Message” button appears in his profile page that allows you to send him/her a message.

How to update your profile information

- ✓ Click on your name or user icon on the top right, to open the dropdown menu. Then from the menu, click on the “Profile” button.
- ✓ In your profile page, you can change your profile image and your cover image (if you hover on them you can see a button that appears). Also you can click the “Edit Profile” button to update your information (first name, lastname,...etc)
- ✓ Update your profile information and click the “Save Changes” button.

How to change password

- ✓ Click on your name or user icon on the top right, to open the dropdown menu. Then from the menu, click on the “Account” button.
- ✓ Type your current password and your new password twice. Then click the “Save Changes” button.
